REQUIREMENTS FOR EMERGENCY TRAVEL CERTIFICATE

An Emergency Travel Certificate (ETC) is issued to stranded Nigerians in Ireland and valid for only an onward journey to Nigeria.

To qualify for this facility, the applicant must prove that he is a Nigerian by presenting a recognised form of identity. Other requirements include but are not limited to the following:

- a. An application letter from the applicant addressed to The Ambassador requesting for the facility.
- b. 2 Passport – sized photographs.
- c. A letter from a Nigerian Legally resident in Ireland guaranteeing the applicant.
- d. Photocopy of the data page of the guarantor’s valid e –passport.
- e. One passport-sized photograph of the guarantor.
- f. A €100.00 postal order fee in favour of the Embassy of Nigeria, Dublin.
- g. In the case of minors/children 16 years and below, both the photocopy of the data page of passport and written consent of father of the child is required.
- h. A confirmed one-way ticket to Nigeria showing flight details of the Applicant

Please note that a successfully processed ETC will be issued a day preceding the travel date.
